NEED A TOW TRUCK?

DID SOMEONE YOU KNOW LOCK THEIR KEYS IN THEIR CAR?

One of the above has happened to all of us sometime during our lifetime. Remember how frustrating it was? Now just think what it would be like to be from "out of town" and not know a friend to call and have your car stalled in the street or accidentally lock your keys in the car. Believe it or not, being a C.O.P. you will, at some time during your patrol life, come upon this exact event. You just might make that persons life a little less complicated with the information below:

Blocking the Road? The first thing is to remember that if the car is off the road it probably does not require getting a BSO deputy involved since they are not on a roadway and not hindering the traffic flow, however, if it is in the roadway, it probably will. You might be able to take some quick steps to get the vehicle off the road and a safer location.

Safety First The first thing to do is position your C.O.P. car behind the stalled vehicle in such a manner as to keep you and the stalled vehicle safe. Turn all overhead lights on, then take your cones out and place them at an angle to divert traffic away from your vehicle. Check with the driver to see if they have towing services with their insurance and ask them to call for service. If they do not and refuse to call a tow truck to remove their vehicle, then a BSO deputy needs to be called immediately. You should stay with the vehicle until the deputy arrives. The deputy may advise the driver to have his car towed. The deputy at the scene may call a tow truck for the disabled car. In the event you get lucky and the driver of the car is cooperative and willing to get a tow truck before a deputy is called, you could provide the driver with some helpful information:
