## **JUST A BIT OF TRIVIA:**

Did you know that the Town of Deerfield was incorporated on June 11, 1925 with 1,300 residents. In 1939 the name was changed to the City of Deerfield Beach. The City's present year-round population of 77,500 grows to approximately 100,000 in the winter months.

## RECENT HAPPENINGS:

*Did you know why a C.O.P. member or any person should not exit their vehicle while on a K-9 search?*

Two of our C.O.P.'s were out patrolling when they came upon a area sealed off by B.S.O.

Upon stopping, the C.O.P.'s were given a description of a suspect and told that if the suspect was spotted to call 911 immediately and not to get out of the car. The reason for staying inside the car was so they would not contaminate the smell the K-9 dogs had picked up from the suspects clothing. The suspect was later found by B.S.O. , and now we know why they were not allowed out of their C.O.P. vehicle. C.O.P. drivers must obey all traffic laws while patrolling. No flashing lights, no speeding, no running stops signs or signal lights unless designated to do so by an officer of B.S.O. Never get out of your vehicle during any search.

## PATROL GUIDELINES:

While patrolling by car or foot remember "No Dogs, Skateboards or Bikes on the beach side of NE 21 Ave. (The street directly in front of the beach) Please be polite when informing persons it is not permitted. Cars parked at "out of order" meters on the beach can and probably will be ticketed. They may be required to appear in court to plead their case. They will be parking there at their own risk. Also tell them to see Barbara Friend at the Deerfield Station at 300 N.E. 2nd St., Deerfield Beach (954-480-4399)

It is a C.O.P.'s responsibility to keep all traffic out of fire lanes in shopping centers, etc. Unless stopped to immediately pick up a person and/or loading packages please notify the vehicle driver that it is a fire lane and parking is not permitted by the City of Deerfield Beach by City Ordinance. Please be polite when asking anyone to move their vehicle.
